Synopsis

God asks a seamstress to create a special friend for His children — “one who is soft yet strong, kind yet brave.” She sews a bear by hand, praying over it three times as it takes shape. The little Guardian waits by the window until a child needs him most. When darkness closes in around her bed, he stands between the child and the shadows and says, “*Not this child. Not today. Not ever.*” God's love shines from him, drives back the darkness, and the little girl is safe — and never alone again. The story is told in first person, in the warm voice of the Guardian Bear himself.

Why It Matters (Story Angles for Media)

- A hometown, multi-generational Lowcountry story: born in Charleston, raised in Summerville, now in Moncks Corner — with tri-county roots that touch several local readerships.
- A mother-and-daughter creative team publishing their debut book together.
- A gentle, practical tool that helps young children (ages 3–6) process nighttime fear and anxiety through faith and comfort.
- A real family tradition behind the book: created for a grand-niece's 2nd birthday, honoring a late great-aunt who handmade a gift for every child in the family.

- The Guardians are real, too — each is handcrafted and prayed over in South Carolina, extending the story into a keepsake companion.

The Guardian Companions

Beyond the book, each Guardian is a one-of-a-kind, handcrafted stuffed companion made in South Carolina. A prayer inspired by Deuteronomy 33:12 is ironed inside before a single stitch is sewn, then recited three times during creation. Every Guardian arrives numbered, with a prayer card, care instructions, an Official Guardian Certificate, and a description card.
